

Declaration of Minerals Conflict Free Conformity

Profcon AB herein declare the Minerals Conflict-Free on all products supplied to customers.

Profcon AB is taking and will take due diligence within our supply chain to assure "DRC ConflictFree" for the Minerals of gold(Au), tantalum(Ta), tungsten(W), cobalt(Co) and tin(Sn) are not derived from or sourced from mines in conflict areas of the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), or illegally taxed on trade routes, either of which are controlled by non-governmental military groups, or unlawful military factions. Trade routes not confirmed to be "conflict Free" include direct exports from the DRC, as well as exports through Rwanda, Uganda, Burundi, Tanzania and Kenya (countries of whom the U.N. Security Council note are global export routes for DRC-mined minerals).

Profcon AB would like to confirm minerals used in all products are "DRC Conflict-Free".

Profcon AB hereby formulated this Conflict minerals Policy and makes following commitments:

- 1. Not to purchase conflict minerals from mines in the Conflict Regions.
- 2. Request its suppliers to refuse to use Conflict Minerals from the Conflict Regions and present a signed Conflict Mineral Report Template (version 5.10) to Profcon AB.
- 3. Request our suppliers to notify their upstream/downstream suppliers to follow Minerals Conflict-Free requirements.
- 4. Continuing our efforts to source conflict-free minerals from the DRC and demand our suppliers to follow this carefully.
